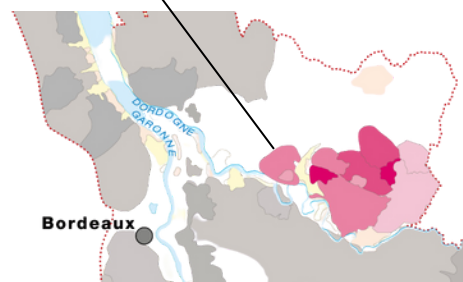


Château Puy Guilhem

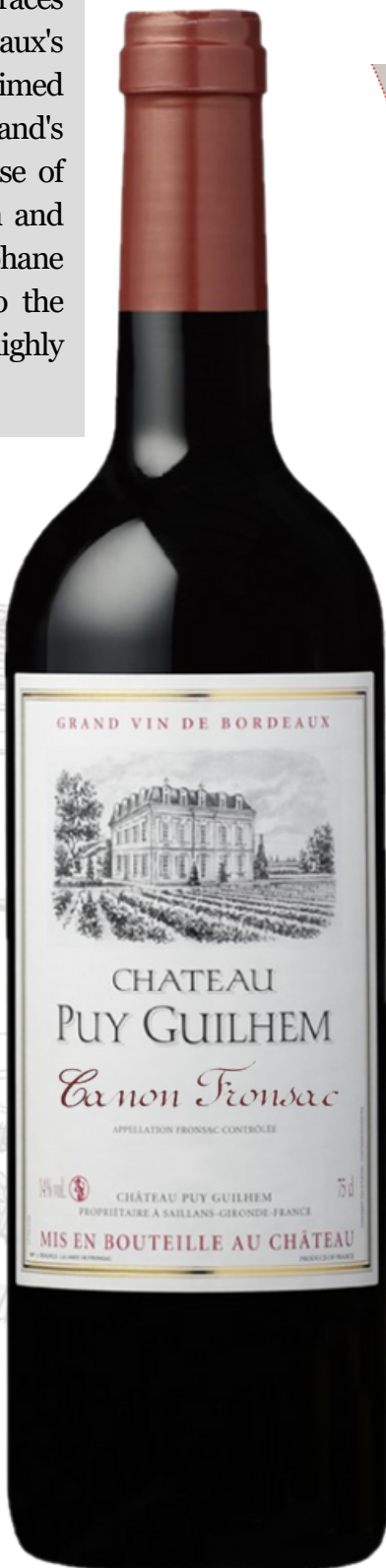
