

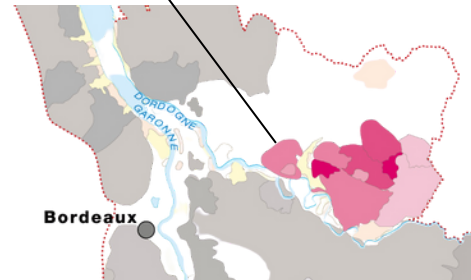
Château Puy Guilhem
